Update 5 - Weather

Dear Customers,

We are very pleased to report that the situation in the port of Rotterdam has eased a little, at least for a short time yesterday.

Yesterday we were able to run the first train ex Rotterdam to Neuss. So we are able to operate one departure from Neuss to Rotterdam today.

Late yesterday evening we received the news that all terminals in Rotterdam, with the exception of EMX, are again accessible on the rail side. We just received the message that currently neither EMX, RWG nor APMT can be reached by train. Please find attached the presentation and information of Pro Rail.

We are therefore forced to withdraw our train from the EMX and to bring the load on the train back to Neuss. A departure of the train is planned for this afternoon ex Rotterdam with arrival tonight in Neuss.

Another train from last week is currently still stuck at APMTII waiting to be shunted to ECT to be unloaded at ECT. The route is currently not accessible, which means that there will be further delays in the arrival at ECT and the containers from the export are currently still on the train.

We will of course keep you informed about the progress.

Of course we are working hard to reduce the effects of this "force majeure" (cause weather situation) to a minimum.

At the same time we kindly ask for your understanding that we cannot assume any liability for further delays and the consequential costs, but are even forced to charge the additional costs incurred to you.

We thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
